

Summerfest: July 18 & 19, 2009



This year is our **24th Annual** Summerfest. **We need all parishioners to help make it successful!** Sign up sheets will be out in the fellowship hall the weekend of June 6th & 7th. Please sign up for a 2 hour shift in a booth of your choice either on Saturday, July 18th or Sunday, July 19th. Working in a booth is a sure way to visit with friends and get to know some new faces. Best of all, they will be coming to you, not you having to seek them out.

We will do Set-Up Saturday morning at 8:30am. Cordless drills are a big help. If you have a picnic table that can be used for the weekend, please drop it off in the old parking lot or call a chairperson and we will arrange to pick it up.

Below is a list of items we are asking you to donate for the various booths. No need to do all, just donate what you can. Please bring all the items Friday 8am-4:30pm or Saturday morning prior to noon. Bring items—unless stated—to the old church basement. Use the southwest wooden door between the Church & Rectory. Areas will be marked for the individual booths.

Dinner: Last names beginning with L-Z, 2 non-refrigerated (HOMEMADE-please!!) pies in non-returnable container. Bring to fellowship hall.



Cake Walk: Last names beginning with A-K, 2 homemade cakes in throw away containers. Bring to fellowship hall.

Country Store: 4 items of \$1.00 or less value. Examples: canned foods, pop, juice boxes, pencils, pudding cups, notebooks, deck of cards, small potted plants.

Children's Bingo: A \$5.00 value new toy.



Silent Auction: New or next to new items. Bring items to designated area in basement, please fill out bid form and tape it to your item.

Grandma's Attic: Basic garage sale items. No need to price your items. NO clothing or junk.

Basket Raffle: Each basket should have a theme. Individuals or groups can put together a basket. Examples: tackle box, scrap booking, crafts, pet treats, movie night, spa night, baking set, etc.

2 o'clock Auction: Quilts, sports tickets, and donated items will be auctioned. Donated items can be new or used in good clean working condition. Items can be delivered to the church grounds on Saturday, July 18, from 10am—2pm. An auction coordinator will determine if items can be used for this auction. Examples: car, lawn mower, garden items, bikes, tents, picnic table, etc...

Grand Raffle: Please turn in raffle tickets as you sell them. If you need more tickets please contact Mardelle Pintok (253-2006) or Deb Thompson (253-1759). The more tickets we sell, the more profit the Summerfest will make! More raffle tickets are also available at the Parish Office.
