*Each family is asked to sign up to help with at least one fund raiser each year.
You will be called with information prior to the fund raiser(s) that you have checked below:*

1. _____ **Christmas Cookie/Candy/Gift Sale: December 12th & 13th, 2009**
Volunteers are asked to sign up for a two hour shift to help with setup, sales, or clean up during the sale. Each family is asked to make 6 dozen Christmas cookies or candy and bring them to the church prior to the sale. Profit last year: \$3,233.60.
2. _____ **Pizza Sales: January & September 2010**
Volunteers help take orders and make the pizzas.
3. _____ **Chili Cook Off & Bingo Social: January 31st**
Volunteers are asked to make their favorite recipe of chili and bring it for this Sunday afternoon event. Knights of Columbus members have hosted this each year.
4. _____ **Fish Fries: Friday evenings of Lenten Season**
We are looking for new co-chairs for this fund raiser. Check here _____ if you are willing to consider this. Many volunteers are also needed. Because of health concerns, children younger than 9th grade cannot work in the kitchen or in the serving line.
5. _____ **Bake Sale: late April or early May after weekend Masses**
We are looking for a chair person and a couple of helpers to coordinate a Bake Sale featuring breads.
6. _____ **Brat Sale at Coborn's Superstore: June**
We are looking for a co-chair and workers to take two hour shifts selling brats & pop outside Coborn's. Check here _____ if you are willing to be a Co-Chair.
7. _____ **Craft Fair/Pies & Parking: Friday, Saturday, & Sunday after Labor Day**
Volunteers needed to donate apples, help prepare pie filling and crust, package & sell pies, and park cars.
8. _____ **Rummage Sale: second week of October (Fri, Sat, & Sun)**

Set up is done on Thursday evening, and the sale continues during the day on Friday, Saturday, and after Masses.
